VERMONT by the Numbers:

- 625,000** Population of Vermont and we are NOT growing.
- 345,000** Vermonters in the Labor Force, which has been in decline.
- +90,000** Vermonters over age 65 years old from 2000 to 2030.
- 33,000** Vermonters from 25 to 65 years old by 2030.
- 75,500** Children in our public K – 12 school system.
- 36,000** Children between the ages of 1 day and 5 years old.

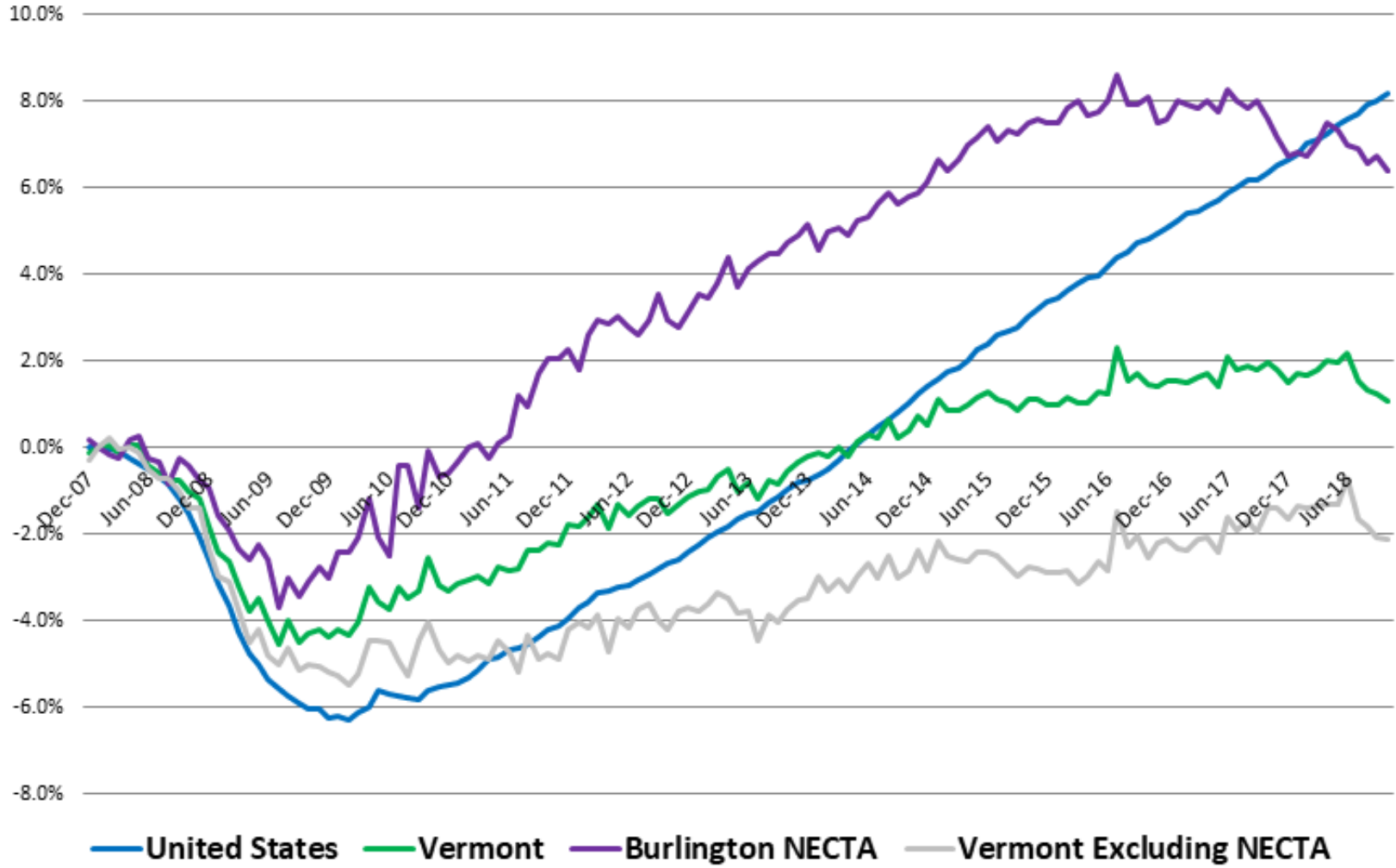
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Vermont faces stagnant population growth with a declining labor force.

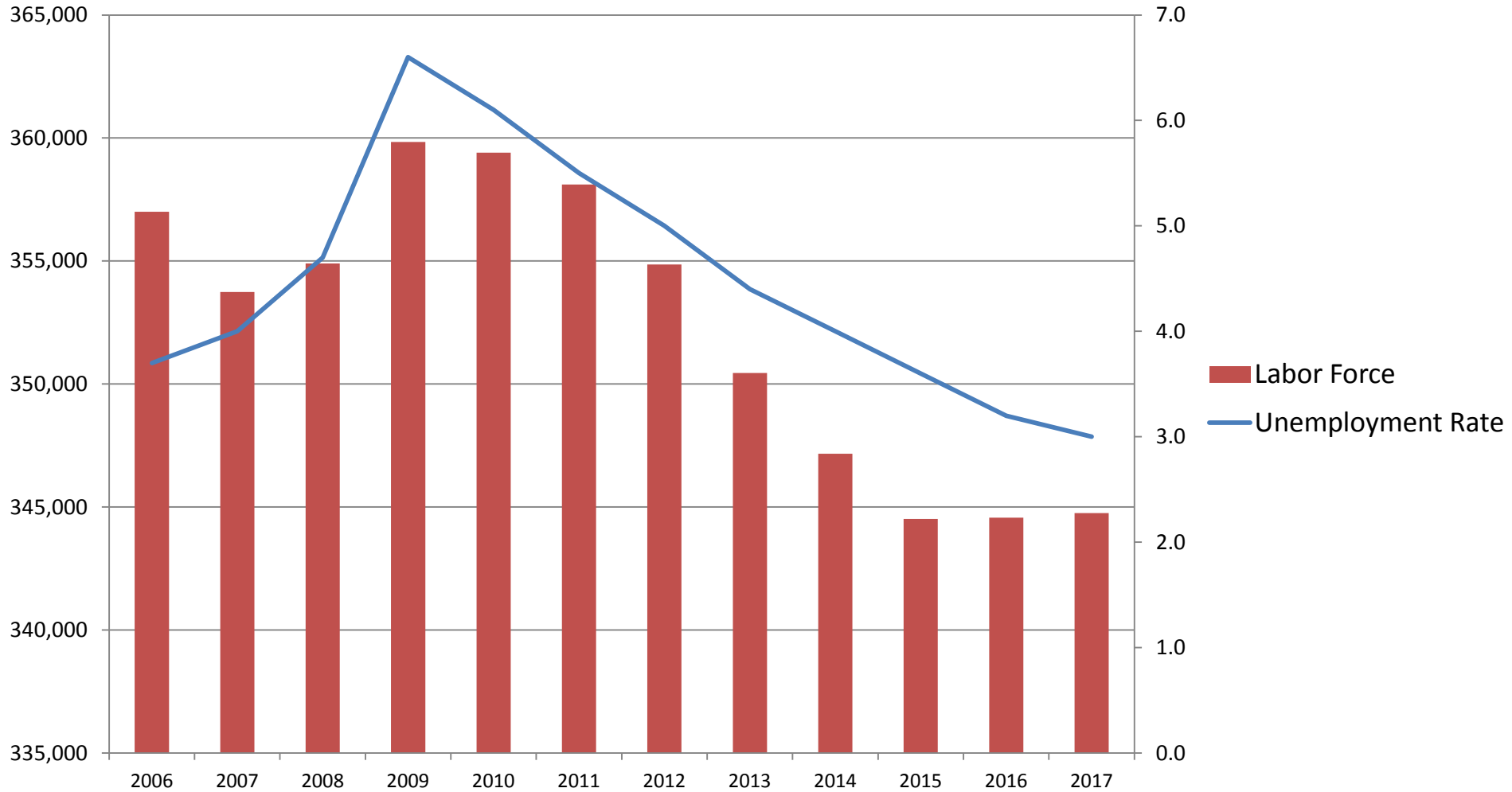
There are skills misalignments where positions exist or are being created.

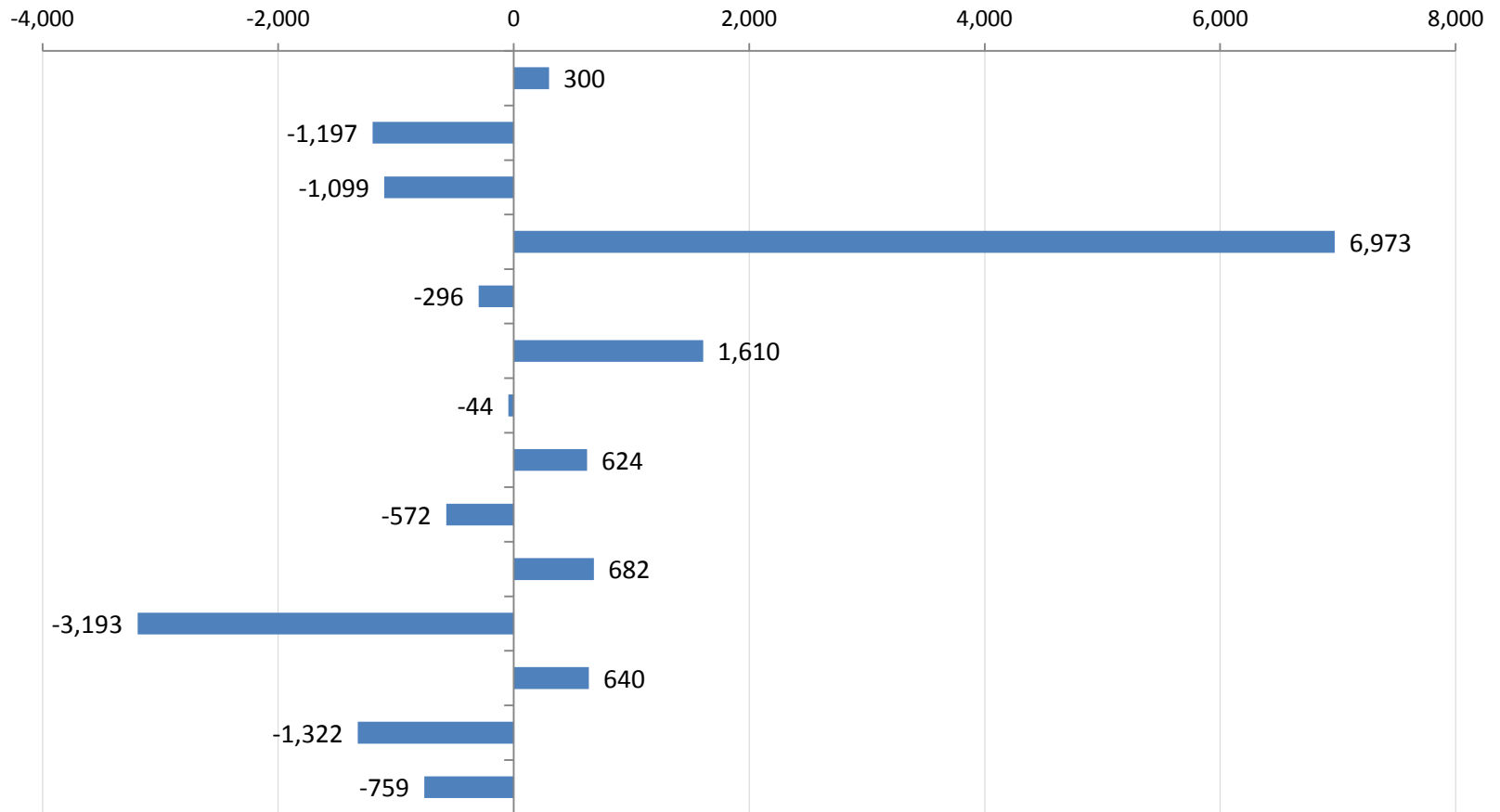
% Change in Jobs & Duration in Months since December 2007: Total Nonfarm Jobs, seasonally adjusted



Total Vermont Labor Force and Unemployment Rate: 2006 - 2017



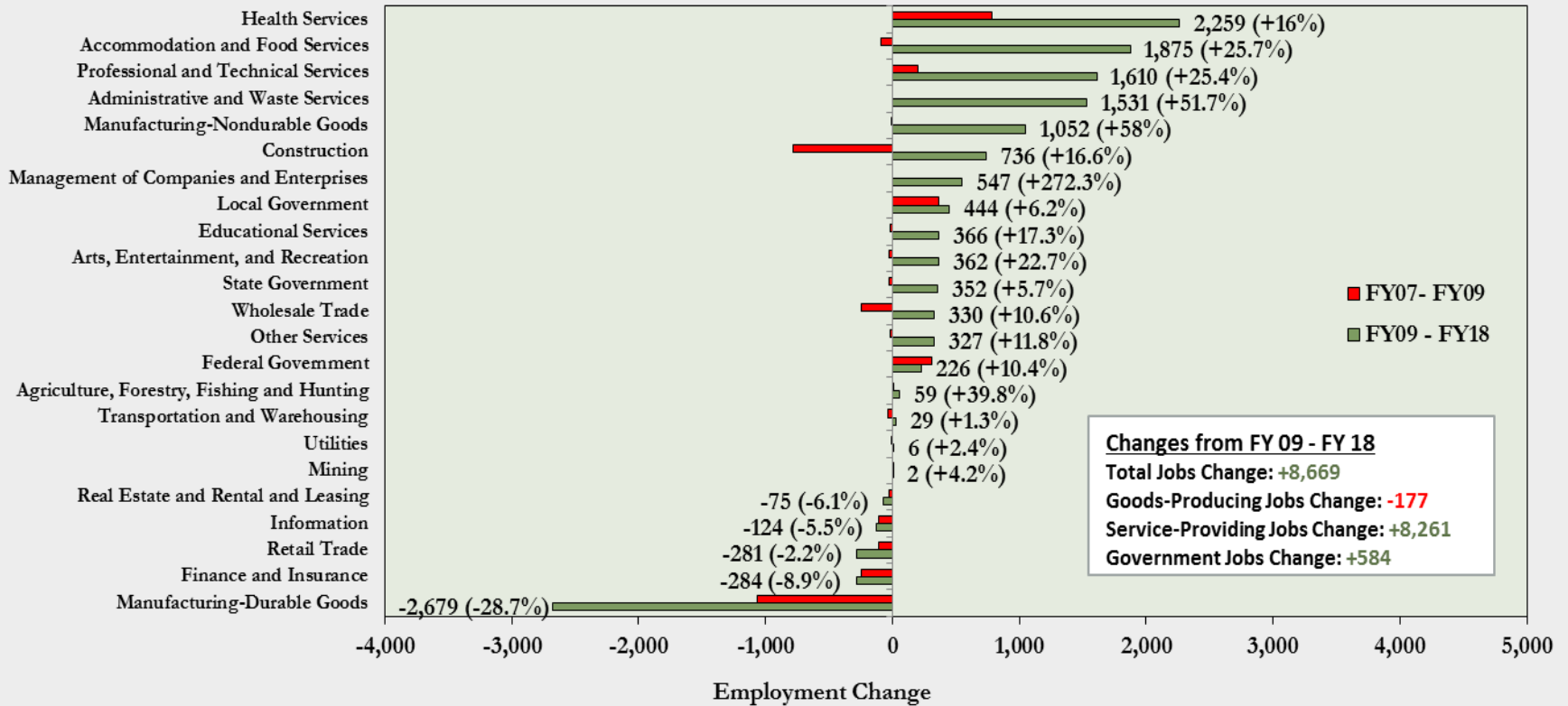
Employment Change: Peak Employment June '07 - June '18

Change in Payroll Jobs from FY 2009 to FY 2018 in Chittenden County, with Percent Change from FY 2009

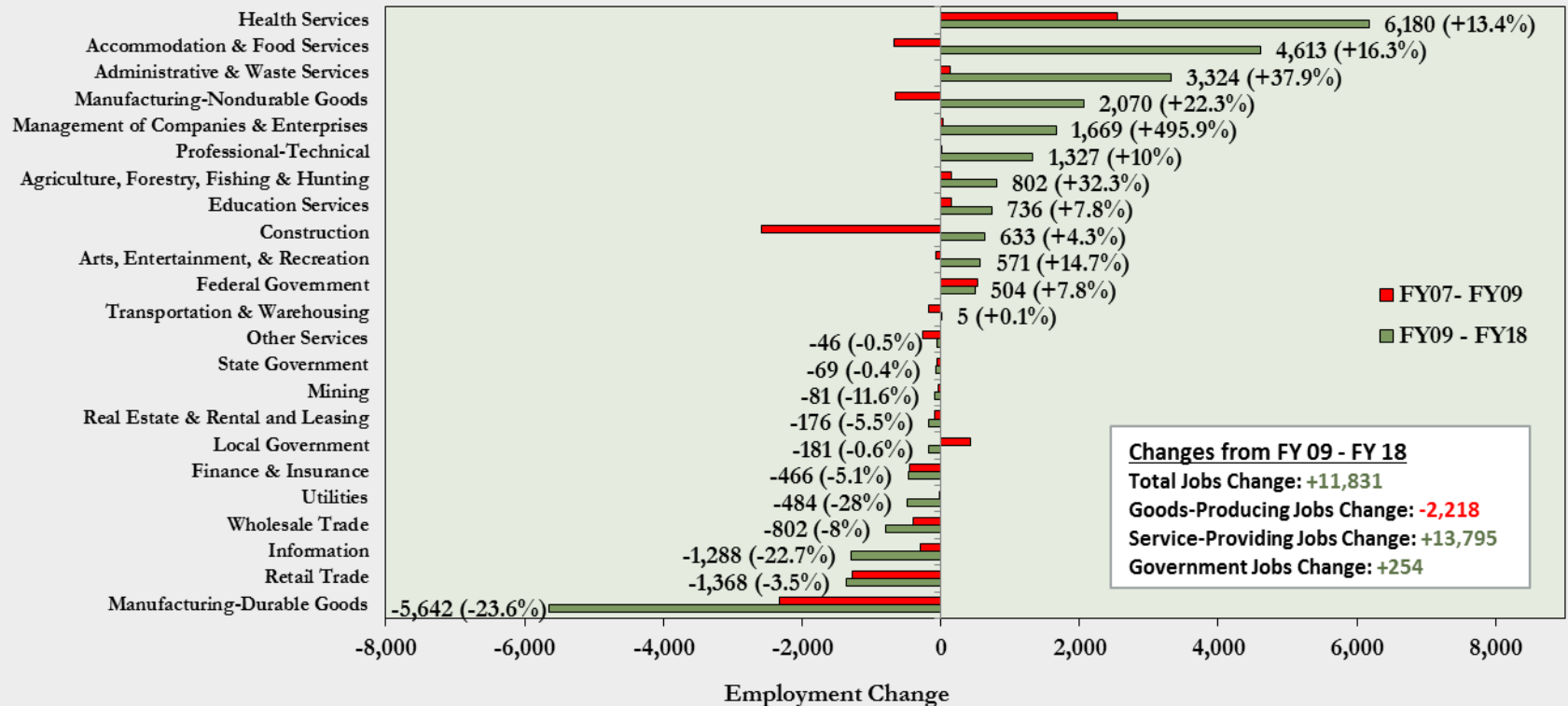
